

Dear colleagues,

We would like to encourage you to submit new exceptional research focusing on analytical and bioanalytical innovations to the journal *Analytical and Bioanalytical Chemistry* (www.springer.com/abc).

Manuscripts can be full Research Papers or Communications, presenting original, unpublished work on new analytical method developments or innovative analytical applications to be in agreement with the journal's aims and scope. The Editors would like to point out that according to the editorial policy each submitted paper is subject to customary peer-review procedures and will be prescreened by the Editors first. Criteria for acceptance of a contribution include receipt of two positive referee reports by renowned experts of the respective field.

You will find the journal's 'Aims and Scope' and 'Instructions for Authors' on the ABC homepage at <u>www.springer.com/abc</u>. Here are some further details on research article types:

- For a full **Research Paper**, paper length must be appropriate to content. There is no strict page limit, but ABC advises a maximum length of up to 6 000 words including 20-30 references, plus 4-6 figures and 1-3 tables. Extensive tables, procedures, computer programs or animated graphics should be presented in form of Electronic Supplementary Material.
- A **Communication** consists of a concise report of research of high quality and broad interest to ABC's target audience. This may include 'proof-of-principle' or a discovery that demonstrates the novel utility of a technique. Given that a Communication is less lengthy than a Research Paper, authors must clearly justify in the text and cover letter why a focused report of their original research findings is warranted, instead of the more comprehensive information given in a Research Paper.

Please **submit** your paper online directly to the ABC editorial office at http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/abc, preferably till March 31, 2025, and clearly indicate that the submission is dedicated to the collection of **LACE 2024 / BrMet**. We advise you to clearly point out novelty and analytical significance both in your cover letter and in the paper abstract, to ensure that this essential information is visible for Editors and reviewers.

Positive peer review preconditioned, accepted papers will be published **online within less than 20 days** on average after acceptance, fully citable by DOI (Digital Object Identifier) and including color figures in color free-of-charge. Publication in an issue is scheduled for October 2025.
